WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Santa Cruz City Schools District has determined that it shall be necessary to reduce or discontinue the particular kinds of services of the District as itemized in Exhibit "A" at the end of the current school year;

And

WHEREAS, it shall be necessary to terminate at the end of the 2009-10 school year the employment of certain certificated employees of the District as a result of this reduction or discontinuance in particular kinds of service;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent or designee is directed to send appropriate notices to all employees whose services shall be terminated by virtue of this action. Nothing herein shall be deemed to confer any status or rights upon temporary or categorically funded project certificated employees in addition to those specifically granted to them by statute.

DETERMINATION OF TIE BREAKING CRITERIA IN ADULT EDUCATION FOR
2010-2011

Pursuant to provisions of Education Code section 44955, the Board of Education is required to determine the District needs should it become necessary to determine the order of termination for employees who first rendered paid service to the District on the same day.

To meet the requirements of section 44955, the Board of Education of the Santa Cruz City Schools District determines the needs of the District and the students thereof, for the 2010-2011 school year in the following priority order:

CRITERION #1: Hours of service in adult education school (all programs)

CRITERION #2: Hours of service in a specific adult education program

If a tie remains after applying the above criteria, the tie shall be broken by lot.
